- 1. A conservatorship is the least restrictive alternative to protect the conservatee. Thomas Hanlon be appointed limited co-conservators of the person of Donald Thomas Hanlon and
- 2. The following limited powers under Probate Code Section 2351.5 be granted to the coconservators and the conservatee's rights be limited in the same areas:
- a) The power to fix the residence or specific dwelling of the limited conservatee;
- b) The power to access confidential records and papers of the limited conservatee;
- c) To control the right of the limited conservatee to contract;
- d) The power to give or withhold medical consent for the limited conservatee;
- e) The power to make decisions regarding the education of the conservatee;
- 3. Pursuant to Probate Code §1830, the conservator(s) file a proof of mailing for Notice of Conservatee Rights (GC-341) within thirty (30) days of appointment;
- 4. A nonappearance hearing on the conservators' filing of the following documents be set for October 30, 2024.
- a. Level of Care Confidential General Plan (PR-22)
- b. Determination of Conservatee's Appropriate Level of Care (GC-355), to be filed within sixty (60) days of appointment
- 5. The conservators attend conservator education classes and a Proof of Completion be filed with the Court within six (6) months of being appointed conservator.
- 6. The assessment of \$850 is ordered and deferred at this time.
- 7. The conservatorship be reviewed in one year's time.
- 8. The private defender is discharged.

Petitioners are directed to appear and explain their failure to file proof of personal service to the proposed conservatee as directed by the court on March 20, 2024 and what efforts they have made to guarantee compliance with future court orders. Absent objection, the court intends to accept independent counsel's request to accept modified notice to GRANT the Petition and to make the following orders:

- 1. A conservatorship is the least restrictive alternative to protect the conservatee and Michael T. Nwynn and Lan Huong Da Nguyen are appointed limited co-conservators of the person.
- 2. The request for medical authority powers under Probate Code §2355 is denied, medical powers are granted pursuant to Probate Code section 2351.5.
- 3. The following limited powers are granted to the limited conservators pursuant to Probate Code section 2351.5 and the limited conservatee's civil and legal rights are limited in the following areas:
- To fix the residence or specific dwelling of the limited conservatee;
- To access the confidential records and papers of the limited conservatee;
- To consent or withhold consent to the marriage of, or the entrance into a registered domestic partnership by the limited conservatee;
- The right to contract;
- The power to give or withhold medical consent;
- Decisions concerning the education of the limited conservatee.
- 4. A nonappearance hearing on the conservator's filing of the following documents be set for October 30, 2024.
- a) "Determination of Conservatee's Appropriate Level of Care" (GC-355) to be filed within 60 days of appointment
- b) Level of Care Confidential General Plan (PR-22)
- 5. Pursuant to Probate Code Section 1830, the limited co-conservators file a proof of mailing of the Notice of Conservatee's Rights within thirty (30) days of appointment.



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- 6. The limited co-conservators are exempt from attending the conservator education class.
- 7. The assessment amount of \$850.00 for the cost of this investigation be ordered and deferred at this time.
- 8. The limited conservatorship be reviewed in one (1) year.
- 9. The private defender is discharged.
